The Illinois State Police (ISP), Division of Forensic Services (DFS), Forensic Sciences Command (FSC) maintains six operational (caseworking) forensic science laboratories located across the state, and a Training and Applications Laboratory (T/A). The FSC Headquarters office, in Springfield, provides supervisory and administrative support for all ISP forensic science laboratories. The operational forensic science laboratories receive physical evidence from user agencies and conduct the appropriate scientific examinations. The T/A Laboratory consists of the Research & Development (R&D) Laboratory, and the Statewide Training Program. The R&D Laboratory, located in Springfield, conducts studies to enhance current scientific techniques and develop/validate new analytical procedures; this laboratory also may conduct limited case analysis. The Statewide Training Program conducts training for newly hired and current employees of the FSC, and operates out of Chicago and Springfield.

The Forensic Science Center at Chicago (FSC-C) provides services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, footwear/tiretracks, forensic biology/DNA, latent prints, toxicology, and trace chemistry (including microscopy). This laboratory serves primarily the Chicago Police Department and other police agencies within the suburban Chicago area (population approx. 7 million).

The Joliet Forensic Science Laboratory (Joliet) provides forensic science services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, footwear/tiretracks, forensic biology/DNA, and latent prints. Approximately 200 law enforcement agencies across seven counties are served by the laboratory (population approx. 2.5 million).

The Rockford Forensic Science Laboratory (Rockford) provides forensic science services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, footwear/tiretracks, forensic biology/DNA, and latent prints. Approximately 167 law enforcement agencies across 11 counties are served by the laboratory (population approx. 1 million).

The Springfield Forensic Science Laboratory (Springfield) provides forensic science services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, footwear/tiretracks, forensic biology/DNA, latent prints, and toxicology. Approximately 300 law enforcement agencies across 29 counties are served by the laboratory (population approx. 1.5 million). The DNA Indexing Unit, which administers the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS) for the entire state, is also part of this laboratory.

The Morton Forensic Science Laboratory (Morton) provides forensic science services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, forensic biology/DNA, and latent prints. Approximately 319 law enforcement agencies across 20 counties are served by the laboratory (population approx. 1.1 million).

The Metro-East Forensic Science Laboratory (Metro-East), located in Belleville, provides forensic science services in the following specialties: drug chemistry, firearms/toolmarks, footwear/tiretracks, forensic biology/DNA, latent prints, and trace chemistry. An evidence receiving/return facility is also located in DuQuoin. Approximately 363 law enforcement agencies across 32 counties are served by the laboratory (population approx. 1.2 million).

The ISP has regionalized some forensic services (e.g., toxicology, trace chemistry) and those services are not performed at all laboratories. However, all such services are available to Illinois law enforcement agencies and the court system; cases are received by the local ISP laboratory, then transferred by ISP to another ISP laboratory that performs the needed service.

Footnotes

- 1 All reasonable efforts have been made to ensure the accuracy of the data in this report within the limitations of the current Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS). As of 12/2018, ISP lab figures are reported as "assignments" (i.e. work requested on a case) and not "cases".
- 2 Offense data is based on the offense in the LIMS at the time this report is generated.
- 3 ISP Total includes Outsourcing whenever listed. Outsourced assignments (i.e., assignments sent to a vendor laboratory) remain on the laboratory's backlog until the data is returned to ISP, reviewed by ISP, a report issued to the agency and uploaded to CODIS (if applicable). The Outsourced column is the subtotal of those assignments.
- 4 "Cases Received" is the number of new assignments created within the section at the laboratory; it does not include cases transferred to that laboratory from another ISP laboratory.
- 5 An assignment is considered "Completed" when the analysis is finished, mandatory technical reviews are completed and the report is issued to the submitting agency.
- 6 "Cases Awaiting Analysis" includes all assignments unstarted or in-process.
- 7 As of 12/2018, "Backlog" is defined as all "in-progress" and "unstarted" assignments in the section, regardless when received/created.
- 8 The age is based on the date the assignment was created in the section.
- 9 Prior to 12/2018, cases "Received within the past 30 days" were considered "newly submitted" and not included in the "Backlog".
- 10 Outsourced Forensic Biology assignments that are forwarded for DNA analysis within the Outsourcing laboratory are not tracked separately by ISP.
- 11 "Cases Received" includes assignments "Forwarded for DNA" from Forensic Biology and cases/assignments submitted directly from an agency.
- 12 "Offender Samples" include all eligible individuals pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3 et seq and 20 IL Adm. Code Part 1285. All "Offender Samples" are analyzed and uploaded by the DNA Indexing Unit.
- 13 "Backlog" is defined as all "in-progress" and "unstarted" "Offender Samples" that are eligible for CODIS upload.
- 14 ISP is responsible for the operation of CODIS in Illinois. In addition to the ISP laboratories, the Northeastern Illinois Regional Crime Laboratory (NIRCL) and the DuPage County Forensic Science Center (DuPage) participate in CODIS.
- 15 The ISP R&D Laboratory does not have a separate CODIS connection.
- 16 "Unknown DNA Case Profiles" includes all evidence profiles uploaded to CODIS by the casework laboratories in Illinois, including NIRCL and DuPage. Profiles developed by the Outsourcing laboratory are returned to the ISP laboratory for upload to CODIS, if applicable.
- 17 When an unknown DNA profile developed from evidence matches a known "offender's" DNA profile, or when it matches an unknown DNA profile from another crime, the match is referred to as a "hit". DNA profiles remain in CODIS indefinitely, therefore a hit can occur any time another case or offender profile is uploaded to CODIS. Hits do not correlate to the work performed during a given reporting period (e.g., hits counted in the quarter may involve a case or offender uploaded anytime since 1998).
- 18 "CODIS Hits" include case-to-case and case-to-offender hits. Per FBI policy, case-to-case hits only count as one hit.
- 19 Hits from out-of-state laboratories to Illinois "offenders" are credited to the DNA Indexing Unit. Out-of-state laboratories are not required to provide the offense when processing hits with Illinois. If the data was provided, it is included.
- 20 After an agency is notified of a CODIS hit to an individual in the database, additional investigation by the agency may be required to determine if the hit is probative and the individual is of interest to the investigation. If so, a DNA sample from that individual may be collected and submitted to the laboratory for confirmation.
- 21 Personnel counts are as of the last day of the quarter.
- 22 Forensic Scientists cross-training from one discipline to another are not counted in "Training" and are only counted in the discipline in which they are being cross-trained.
- 23 Forensic Scientists in short-term temporary assignments are included in their primary discipline.
- 24 Forensic Scientist Trainees are counted as a statewide total per discipline and are not included in the total for the laboratory location where the training is being conducted.
- 25 Footwear/Tiretracks (FW/TT) is a sub-discipline of Firearms/Toolmarks; it is not a primary discipline to which scientists are assigned full-time. Forensic Scientists who perform FW/TT analysis are counted in their primary discipline, and may or may not work FW/TT cases in any given quarter.
- 26 This report only includes new case submissions to ISP Laboratories during the specified quarter where an offense classified in the Illinois Uniform Crime Reporting (IUCR) categories of 'Criminal Sexual Assault' and/or 'Sex Offenses' was indicated as an offense on the case at the end of the quarter.
- 27 For the purpose of this report, if more than one agency submits evidence on the same case, the case is only attributed to the first investigating agency listed in the LIMS.
